Success in Value-Based Care is challenging! As we enter into the last quarter of the year, we need to focus on closing patient *Gaps in Care* and completing our *Hierarchical Condition Categories (HCC)* capture in order to achieve success in our collaborations.

Gaps in Care tell us which of the established ideal or standard performance measures have not been completed. The requirements for closing the Gaps in Care have become multilayered in select measures which requires a screening or test and acceptable result. In most cases the results can be delivered to the health plan through the use of CPTII codes and/or entry into CareScreen® or health plan population tool. The fewer Gaps in Care the more quality performance metrics we meet.


HCC are a part of a CMS risk adjustment model to estimate patient health resource use and calculate reimbursement to health plans. Accurate coding of all conditions is essential to achieve the contractual Medical Loss Ratio (MLR). HCCs must be recorded every year even when you have recorded in the last year. Identifying all associated conditions/complications related to the condition is vital.

Your efforts in these critical areas are needed for our network to achieve success. Establish a process to ensure we finish strong to earn bonus dollars and shared savings. CSMS-IPA will continue to support you with reports and your CSMS-IPA Resource can help you so please reach out to them. **Together we can achieve success.**
